


E-Signature

Preconditions –

Valid Aadhaar number linked with registered mobile number should be entered in Authorized Signatory Tab.

Steps for doing E-Signature-

1. The taxpayer clicks the SUBMIT WITH E-SIGNATURE button.

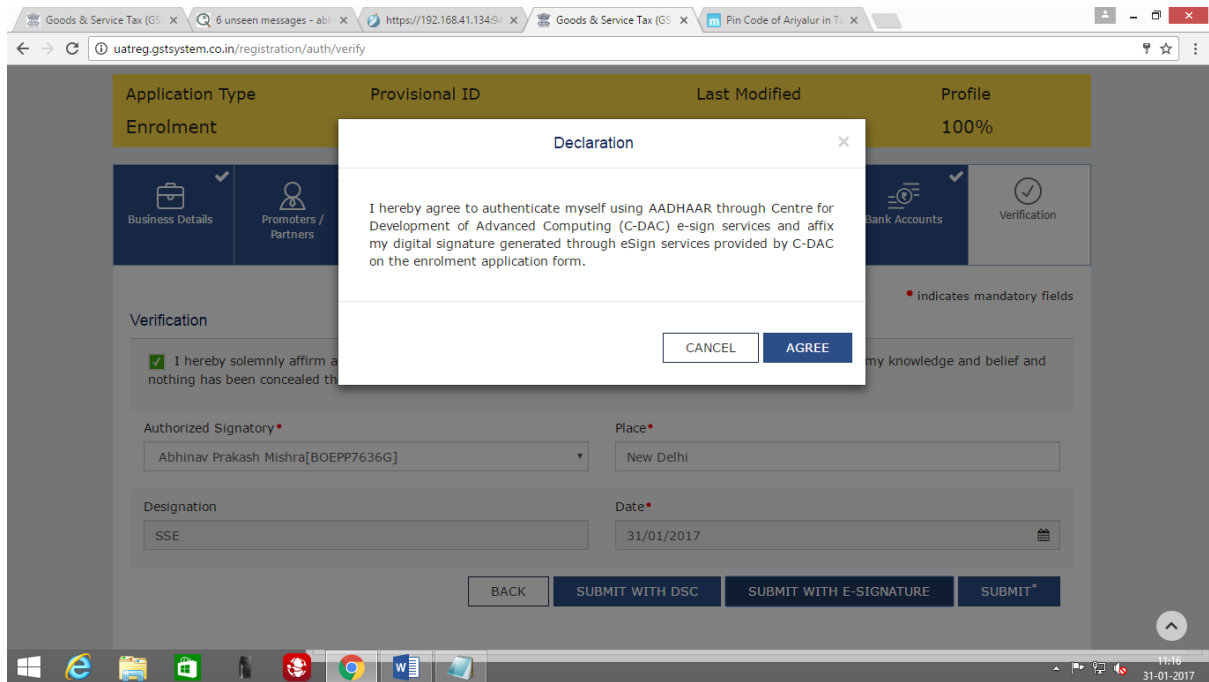

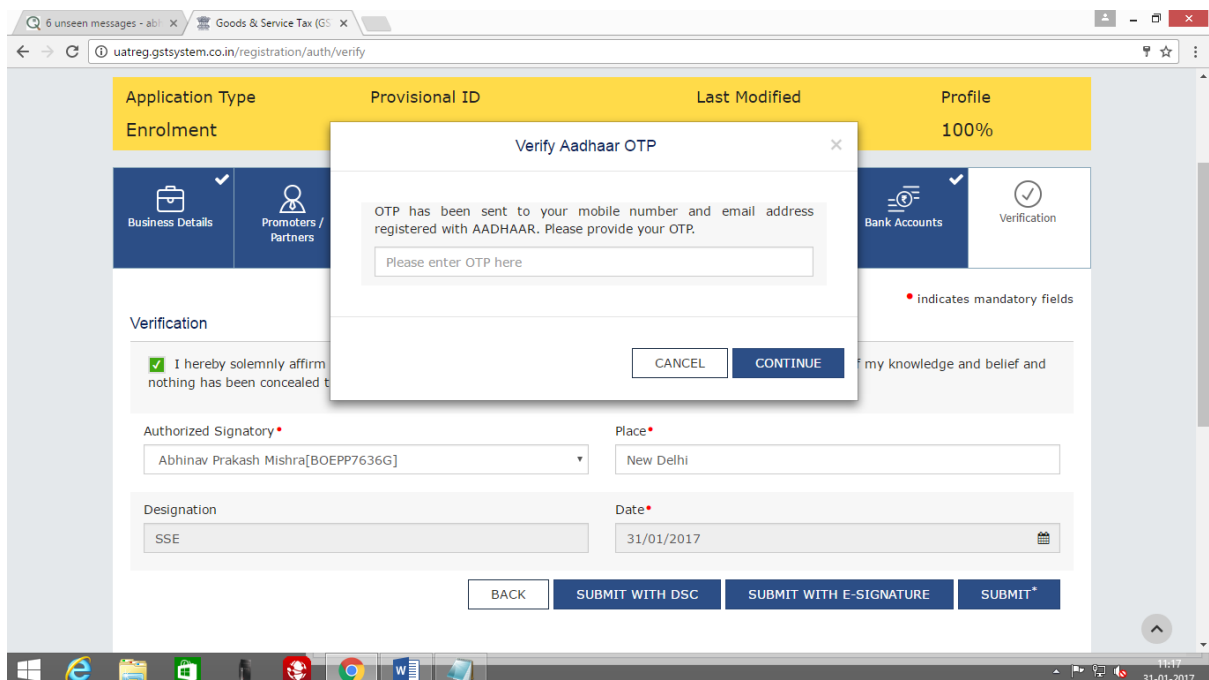

2. In the Declaration box click the AGREE button.

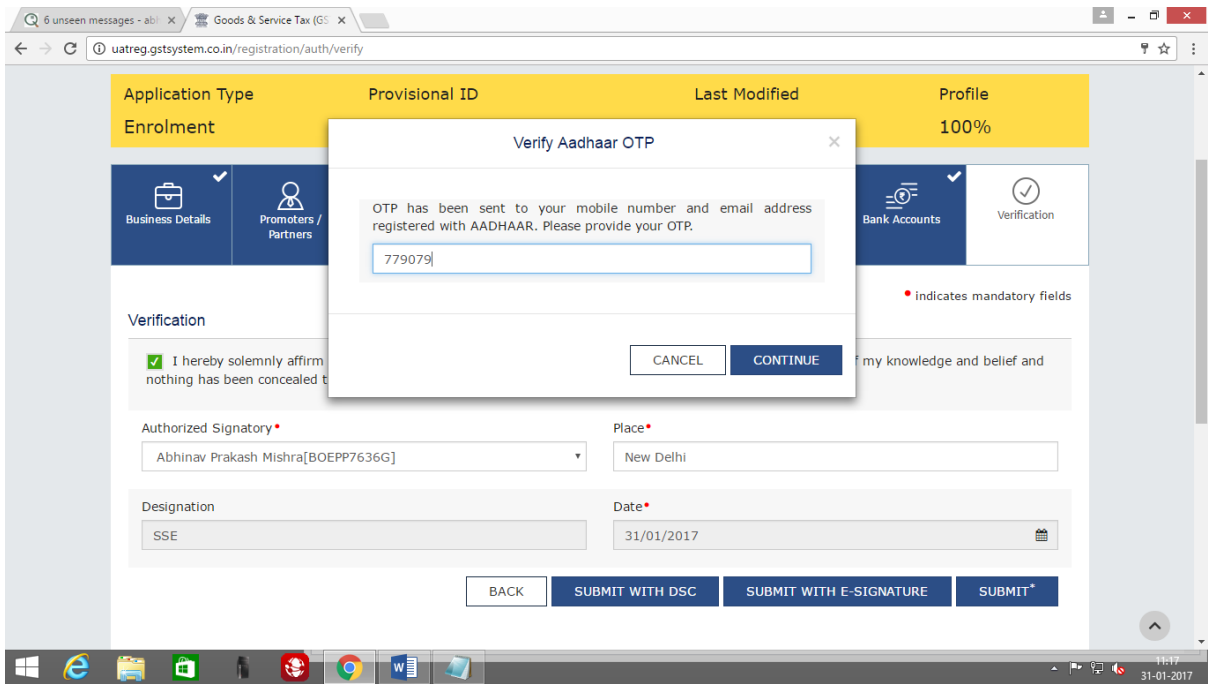


3. After validating the Aadhaar Number, the GST Common Portal sends a request to UIDAI system to send a One Time Password (OTP).

- a) UIDAI system sends an OTP to mobile number registered against Aadhaar number.
- b) The GST System prompts the taxpayer to enter the OTP.



4. The taxpayer enters the OTP and submits the Enrolment Application or the document.



5. The e-Signing process is completed.
